WHY –

Currently, bible camps do not exist in the country of Chad. There is an important need and a deep desire for camping ministry in Chad, where youth can build each other up, while adults teach and encourage them in the faith. Thousands of young people in Chadian churches would benefit from a structured camp experience. Some churches plan events, but often there is a lack of space at the church and activities are few. ANIM believes that a Bible camp would be a great opportunity for the multitudes of children in Chadian churches. This will be a place to have fun and build lasting, personal relationships with fellow believers, while maturing spiritually.

THE NEED –

- \$25,000 – Initial planning and enclosing the camp property
- \$7,000 – Installing two solar powered water pumps the water pump
- \$110,000 – Planning and construction of office, cabins, bathrooms, outside seating area

By making these resources available, we hope to build up and encourage the local Christian church and stand firm in the faith alongside the believers in this region.

THE NEED –

\$ 200,000 – Building of a guest rooms, office, conference room, library

\$ 3,000 – One solar water pump along with water tower
